

**Australian Association of Social Workers**

1. Information on how to enter to win a prize forms part of these terms and conditions (**Terms and Conditions**). The Competition is not valid in conjunction with any other offer.

## Definitions

6. For the purposes of these Terms and Conditions:

6.1 **Prize** means

- one (1) AASW "Access Pass" for up to three (3) AASW webinars of choice (valid for 12 months) AND one (1) complimentary, full access registration to any AASW Conference or Symposium (valid until December 31, 2023); Category 1
- one (1) AASW "Access Pass" for up to two (2) AASW webinars of choice (valid for 12 months) Category 2
- one (1) AASW "Access Pass" for up to two (2) AASW webinars of choice (valid for 12 months) Category 3

6.2 **Required Information** means the Eligible Entrant's details including name, member ID, email address, residential address, employment details, country, phone number

6.3 **Registration** means a successfully paid registration to The Conference, using the process as instructed on The Conference website

6.4 **Winner** means an Eligible Attendee who has met the required terms and conditions of entry and participation

6.5 **Gamification** means the process by which points are accrued by performing certain designated actions within the Conference platform as designated by the Event Promoter during the competition period

## Privacy

7. The AASW collects personal information to conduct the Competition and may, for this purpose, disclose such information to third parties, including, but not limited to, agents, contractors, service providers, Competition suppliers and, as required, to Australian and New Zealand regulatory authorities. Validity of an entry is conditional on providing this information. The AASW may, for an indefinite period, unless otherwise advised, use the information for competition, marketing, publicity, research and profiling purposes, including sending electronic messages or telephoning an entrant. Each entrant acknowledges that the information they provide will be collected by or on behalf of the AASW and may be disclosed to other group companies and to third parties that help the AASW deliver its products and services or as required by law. Some of these parties may be located outside of Australia, as set out in the [AASW Privacy Policy](#).

## Eligibility and entries

8. To be eligible to enter to win a Prize, an entrant must, during the Competition Period:

8.1 be a natural person aged 18 years or over, who is an ordinary resident in Australia and not be a company, business or organisation of any description, or an AASW employee, or of any agency associated with this Competition, or any Immediate Family Member of such a person;

8.2 Purchase any ticket type to attend The Conference

8.3 follow any reasonable directions provided by the AASW and/or its representatives in relation to the Competition,

8.4 Complete the activities required of the attendee, as designated by the Event Promoter

8.5 All Attendees will be automatically entered into the Competition by attending the

conference, but attendees are not required to participate in the competition

### **Judging and Prizes**

9. The attendee who accrues the highest total number of points during the relevant competition period will be considered the winner of that category
10. Winners will be announced on the day, at the conference, at the conclusion of each competition period.
11. An Eligible Attendee is entitled to win no more than one (1) Prize. For example, a Category 1 winner will not be eligible to win a Category 2 or 3 prize
12. Once an Attendee has been identified as having accrued the most number of points relevant to their category, the Attendee will receive a confirmation email to the Eligible Entrant's nominated email address advising of successful registration within 7 days of the event concluding
13. The AASW may, in its absolute discretion, ignore any Attendee which it deems to be offensive or inappropriate, or otherwise tampers with the entry process, or which otherwise does not comply with the Terms and Conditions. Ejection from the Conference for violation of attendance terms and conditions renders any possible participation in the competition null and void.
14. The Winner will also be supplied with a point of contact from AASW to organise registration for the Webinar Access Pass and will also be supplied an official AASW letter, confirming eligibility for future complimentary registration at any AASW Conference or Symposium.
15. If a Prize is unavailable, AASW, in its discretion, reserves the right to substitute a Prize for another prize to an equal or greater value and/or specification.
16. Each Prize is not transferable or exchangeable and is not redeemable for cash. Each Prize must be used on or before its nominated expiry date and if not used, the value of the Prize is forfeited.
17. If a Winner is not able to satisfy these Terms and Conditions, or forfeits or fails to accept their respective Prize, then they will be deemed to have forfeited their Prize.
18. AASW's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
19. The AASW reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries and entrants (including an entrant's identity, age and place of residence) and to disqualify any entrant who submits an entry that is not in accordance with these Terms and Conditions, who tampers with the entry process, or who is not otherwise an Eligible Entrant. Errors or omissions may be accepted at AASW's discretion. Failure by the AASW to enforce any of its rights at any stagedoes not constitute a waiver of those rights.

### **General**

20. Entrants consent to AASW using their name and/or image in the event they are a Winner(including photograph, film and/or recording of the same) in any media for an unlimited period without remuneration for the purpose of promoting this Competition (including any outcome), complying with legislative requirements and promoting any products or servicesdistributed and/or supplied by the AASW.
21. If this Competition is interfered with in any way or is not capable of being conducted as reasonably anticipated due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of AASW reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to the fullest extent permitted by law: (a) to disqualify any entrant; or (b) to modify, suspend, terminate or cancel the Competition.
22. Subject to clause 28, AASW (including its officers, employees and agents) excludes all liability (including negligence), for any personal injury; or any loss or damage (including lossof opportunity),

whether direct, indirect, special or consequential, arising in any way out of the Competition, including, but not limited to, where arising out of the following: (a) any technical difficulties or equipment malfunction (whether or not under AASW's control); (b) any theft, unauthorised access or third party interference; (c) any Prize that is late, lost, altered, damaged or misdirected (whether or not after their receipt by AASW); (d) any variation in the Prize value to that stated in these Terms and Conditions; (e) any tax liability incurred by a entrant; or (f) use of the Prize.

Nothing in these Terms and Conditions is intended to exclude, restrict or modify any consumer rights under the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (Cth) (**CCA**) or any other legislation which may not be excluded, restricted or modified by agreement. If the CCA or CGA or any other applicable legislation implies a condition, warranty or term into the Terms and Conditions or provides statutory guarantees in connection with these Terms and Conditions in respect of goods and services supplied (if any), AASW's liability for breach of such a condition, warranty, other term or guarantee is limited to (at AASW's election) to the extent it is able to do so: (1) in the case of supply of goods, AASW doing any one or more of the following: (a) replacing the goods or supplying equivalent goods (b) repairing the goods (c) paying the cost of replacing the goods or of acquiring equivalent goods; and/or (d) paying the cost of having the goods repaired; or (2) in the case of supply of services, AASW doing either or both of the following; (a) supply the services again; and/or (b) paying the cost of having the services supplied again. To the extent that AASW is unable to limit its liability as set out in the previous sentence. AASW limits its liability to the extent such liability is lawfully able to be limited.

25. These Terms and Conditions are governed by the laws of Victoria, Australia. Each entrant (whether or not an Eligible Entrant) submits to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Victoria, Australia.
